

ACCOUNTING INNOVATION CHALLENGE 2018

- Accounting Innovation Challenge 2018 is Singapore's first Hackathon for the accountancy sector.
- It aims to drive a culture of innovation and establish effective collaboration within the accounting sector, to build a future-ready sector.
- The platform will bring together students and professionals from multi-disciplines to develop high-value business ideas and product concepts.
- It is part of the Accountancy Sector Roadmap in driving innovation in the sector.
- Around 200 participants have signed up, coming from Institutes of Higher Learning, start-ups as well as working professionals from various industries. These participants will work on 10 challenge statements revolving around Human Capital, Audit Innovation, Customer Engagement, Governance, Risk and Compliance.
- The Accounting Innovation Challenge (AIC) 2018 is organised by the Singapore Accountancy Commission in partnership with CPA Australia.
- It is supported by the Big 4 accounting firms - Deloitte Singapore, Ernst & Young LLP, KPMG, PwC Singapore. It is also supported by the following accounting professional bodies - Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA), Chartered Institute of Management Accountants (CIMA), Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales (ICAEW), and the national accounting body - the Institute of Singapore Chartered Accountants, as well as the Infocomm Media Development Authority (IMDA) and Singapore Management University (SMU)'s School of Accountancy.
